#### In Memoriam - Terry D. Marriott

The OAHA is extremely sad to have lost one of our most dedicated members and volunteers. Terry Marriott passed away this past month. Terry served in many roles with our organization, including President, Secretary and Treasurer. He also was the keeper of our post office box and our unofficial technology consultant. For our organization's 60th anniversary, we discussed his journey with him:



In 1962, while at college, Terry developed symptoms of what was diagnosed ten years later as Crohn's disease. In September of 1965, he had an ileostomy with complete colectomy at the Mayo Clinic. He experienced quite a few complications in the years after surgery, including having his stoma site moved twice and additional intestinal surgeries to remove fistulas and abscessed areas, leaving very little intestine and a short gut. But nothing slowed Terry down.

He graduated with a PhD in Chemistry and worked as a post doc in mass spectrometry for two years, eventually moving to Houston in September of 1978 to work at Rice University. He travelled extensively for work and pleasure.

Terry told us that through this journey, he learned many things about himself, doctors, the various kinds of inflammatory bowel diseases, other people and himself. We were truly inspired by his undeniable spirit of never giving up or letting his condition or disease control him. Further, Terry unselfishly gave his time and talent to the OAHA so that new ostomates could face their own challenges with perseverance and hope.

We send our heartfelt condolences to Terry's wife, Mary, and the rest of his family. He was one of a kind and we will miss him.
